October 11th, 2023

**The meeting started** with prayers followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were 30 members.

**Treasurer's report.** The \$1000 received from AOH Hunger Project was forwarded to Irish Charities. The accounts are down \$4400.

**Nebraska President's Report.** Omaha was among 5 locations asked to put in a bid to hold the AOH national convention. We have heard back that after the first round of review that we have the best proposal.

**Pro Life report.** There will be a Men's Rosary March to be held in Lincoln on October 14th. It will start at 320 N 16th St. at 11 AM.

**Irish Charities report.** The golf tournament was a huge success with 112 of the 120 golfers that signed up present. Around \$3300 was made for charities.

**The picnic** was held on September 23rd and was a great event. The cabin is booked for next year for the weekend. We are considering having a poker night the night before the picnic next year.

**A discussion was held** on dropping the parade booklet. It costs around \$6000 to produce the booklet. Palm cards have some basic information and a QR code to take the person to our web site where we will have information on AOH plus our advertiser information. One benefit of this is that we will be able to sell more of the highest level of patronage, which at this time is limited by the space available in the booklet. After much discussion a motion was made to drop the booklet in favor of the palm card. Motion passed. A parade planning session will occur every 3rd Wednesday of the month at 7 PM at American Legion Post 1.
