The meeting started with prayers followed by the "Pledge of Allegiance." Present were around 26 members.

The minutes from the January general meeting were approved.

Treasurer report. National and State Dues have been paid.

Nebraska President's Report given by State Deputy John Addy. The national convention is in Orlando, Florida on August 7-10. You can sign up now. You must be a paid member of the AOH in good standing. When you sign up, you will be asked if you are a delegate, please say yes. We want to have as many delegates as possible. Hotel rooms can be reserved now.

Irish Charities report. The paperwork for National's Hungry Project has been submitted.

Parade report. The parade is March 9th. The General O'Neill ceremony has been moved to March 16th at 9:30 (Holy Sepulchre Cemetery) due to the Irish Mass at Holy Cross has been moved to that date at 10:30. 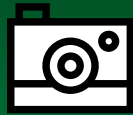

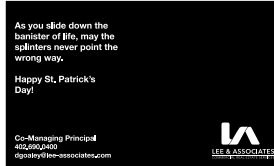
