



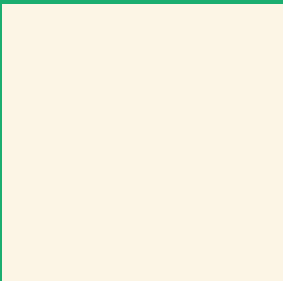

AOH General Meeting Minutes



June 12th, 2024

Location: American Legion Post 1 at 7811 Davenport St. Omaha, Ne 68114

The meeting started with prayers followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present were around 20 members.

Treasurer report. Discussed account balances.

A presentation was provided by Jackie Law, the president of the America's Wall of Honor Foundation.

It included a 57' x 10' Memorial Wall containing nine "seals" forged from dozens of layers of Stainless Steel.

The Presidential Seal, honoring the Commander-In-Chief of the Armed Forces, will be the centerpiece of the Wall; flanked on either side with the official emblems of the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, and National Guard.

Along with the badges of America's First Responders in law enforcement, and fire and rescue. The Wall will tour the United States, and will also feature several Mobile Museums or Education Centers. While not on tour the wall can be found at its Omaha base on 4879 F St.

President's report. Members were reminded of the convention dates on August 7-10 in Orlando Florida. All the brothers that were going were requested to attend a short meeting after the general meeting.

Unfortunately, Shawn Murphy was not chosen to receive the AOH Young Member Award.

Parade Report. At this time 99% of the money for the 2024 parade has been collected. Mary Barrett has been selected to be the 2025 parade Grand Marshall. In preparation for the 2025 parade, the parade meetings will start in August and will occur every 3rd Wednesday of the month. Location will be the American Legion Post 1, main floor.

Irish Charities report. Jeff Johnson discussed the upcoming golf tournament on August 31st at Tregaron. Volunteers are needed along with any items that could serve as swag. Volunteers will get a free meal. Irish Charities application to the Douglas County Visitor Improvement Fund for \$24000 to help offset the cost of putting on the parade in 2025 has been reviewed.

A recommendation that we receive \$11000 from this fund has been forwarded to the county board for a vote.

The picnic will be held in September. A cabin will be rented for 2 days. Friday before the picnic a poker night will be held.

Father Flanagan report. Boystown has put together a nice brochure which will be handed out at the AOH National convention promoting Boystown.

A good showing of members marched in the Florence Days Parade on Saturday May 11th and the Patriotic Parade on Saturday May 25th.

A discussion was held on ways to promote AOH. All members were encouraged to forward the monthly newsletter to friends and family. Also discussed was adding our sponsors to the email list for the newsletter so that they can see what we do.

The JE George parade is coming up on July 4th. The honor guard will march in it. All members are invited to join us. We will meet at Jeff Johnson's house at 9 AM. This is a 2-block parade that is walking only, no vehicles.
