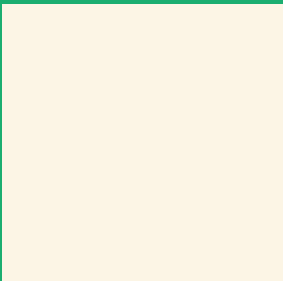

July 10th, 2024

The national convention is August 7th-10th in Orlando Florida. An ad was placed in the convention program to promote Omaha for the next convention.

Parade Report. Mary Barrett has been selected to be the 2025 parade Grand Marshall. We are planning to award the Grand Marshalls sash at the Banquet.

In preparation for the 2025 parade, the parade meetings will start in August and will occur every 3rd Wednesday of the month. Location will be the American Legion Post 1, main floor.
