AOH General Meeting Minutes

August 14th, 2024 Location: American Legion Post 1 at 7811 Davenport St. Omaha, Ne 68114

The meeting started with prayers followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

We had 23 people attending.

The minutes from July's general meeting were approved.

Treasurers report: Treasurer discussed the division accounts. \$9000 was spent on donations this last month. \$3000 was spent on the regular insurance for the division (NOT the parade) this month.

AOH President's report: John Addy discussed the National Convention in Orlando. Big news is that we will be having the AOH National Convention come to Omaha in July of 2026. The convention will be in Atlantic City in 2028. Twelve Hibernians and three lady Hibernians were present at the Orlando convention. Nebraska AOH partnered along with several other small state contingents for a party room and much fun was had. Much work is ahead of us to get ready for the convention. John is going to meet with the city so to gain a better picture of what the city will do and what the division will need to do.

Discussed officer nominations to be held at the general meeting in September. Voting will be held at the October meeting with the installation to be held in November. Golf report: Good on golfers. Have 90 so far. Need staff and volunteers and swag. Swag was collected by John Addy.

Donations: Irish charities and the division each gave \$1000 to each of the following: St. Vincent DePaul, Bethlehem House and Heart ministry. Thank you letters were received from, the first 2. The division has sent out checks to the following charities: Big Red Rugby for \$500, Abortion Dialogue Academy for \$500, Sierra Francis House for \$250, Craoi na Tire Studio of Irish Dance for \$250, New Visions for \$1000. Seminary fund for \$1500, Children Scholarship fund for \$1500, American Legion Post #1 for \$250 and Disc Golf for Life Suicide Prevention for \$150. Another \$1100 is slated for the Madonna School Christmas Party

Parade Report: Mary Barrett will be the Grand Marshall for the parade. An expanded opening ceremony for the parade and an online auction for the parade start are being explored. Monthly parade meetings will be held every third Wednesday at American Legion Post #1 at 7 PM starting in August.

Veterans Report: Keep brother Hugh Spellman in our prayers. He is having health issues.

Banquet Report: It was decided to change the price to \$75, \$15 for bar, \$60 for rest. The open bar will cover 1 keg of Guinness, wine, pop, well liquor, plus Tullamore dew and Jameson up to a designated amount and then we will have a cash bar. The band is booked. The piper has put the banquet on the calendar. The dancers emailed but have not heard from them yet. Suggestions were taken for the following: Lifetime Achievement Award, Hibernian of the Year, Newcomer Award, and the Veteran Award. The Banquet flyer will be ready shortly.

Honor Guard Report: The closing ceremony for Big Red Rugby is coming up. Need color guard to show up. Three people marched at the Santa Lucia Parade. A color guard meeting will be called by Dion to get prepped for the saffron kilts for the color guard.

Father Flanagan League Report: The Fr. Flanagan film was presented to around 125 attendees at the National convention and was well received. The movie will premier nationwide on October 8th.

Historical Report: The president's list is updated. Have submitted an article to the national paper on the JE George parade.

A table has been reserved for the Hibernians at Durham for December 6th. The division has sent in an entry for the Labor Day Parade on September 2nd. Details on where to meet and the time for this parade will be provided via email as we get near the day of the parade.

Omaha's Irish Cultural Center will be having the Irish band Gadan coming to the B Bar on Thursday August 29.

President Lonergan discussed a possible participation bonus program where a \$50 gift card to one of our sponsors is given away 4 times a year to increase participation. One ticket for entry will be given to a person every time they attend an AOH event. Events would include everything except ones they should be at anyway like the banquet and the parade.

The division made a motion to proceed with this participation program which was subsequently passed. The program will start in September and the gift card will be given out quarterly in March, July, September and December.

The meeting was closed with a few prayers, the singing of "The Soldiers Song" and the National Anthem
